Rooms are furnished with a refrigerator, two sets of bunk beds, a desk, chair and individual locker closets for each person. The beds have "under bed" dresser drawers with one drawer per person and space behind the drawers for luggage storage. All rooms are equipped with a heat/air conditioning unit, phone with voicemail and satellite television. The housing has a 24-hr computer lounge and free wireless internet. You must bring your own laptop. Vending machines, an ATM, basketball court, volleyball court, soccer field and a pool are all within walking distance and available for use. Security and dorm check-in are available 24 hrs a day. If you choose, you may bring your own towels and linens; however, these items are available for purchase upon arrival to the dorm as well.
