Job Description:

Lifeguards are responsible for guarding swimmers and for the safe and efficient operations of our aquatics areas. This includes enforcing rules, giving information and answering questions, watching the pools and water slides to make sure that all guests are safe, performing life-saving techniques when needed as described and practiced in lifeguard certification training.

Must be able to perform the following:

Ability to exit the pool at any point without the aid of a ladder or stairs.

Ability to swim 50 meters using the freestyle or breast stroke without stopping.

Ability to swim a distance of 10 feet underwater and retrieve a 10lb diving brick.

Ability to complete training and meet the standards of the Ellis & Associates International Training Program, including First Aid & CPR certification, Swim Rescue, and Spinal Injury Management.

Lifeguard training classes and certification are provided by host employer. Applicants must pass all practical and written tests.

During training and potentially during emergent situations, lifeguards may need to lift to assist in a rescue. You will be trained on proper technique and typically have devices available to assist you.

Description:

Lifeguard training classes and certification are provided by Host Employer. Applicants must pass all practical and written tests. Students must be able to work outdoors in all weather conditions. For reasons of safety, ability to speak and understand English must be excellent. Must pass a mandatory pre-employment drug screen upon arrival . Should be friendly and outgoing. All swimmers must be able to:

- o Complete the training program (written and swim) including CPR, First Aid, swim rescue, and spinal injury management*
- o Exit the pool without using stairs or ladder*
- o Retrieve a 10lb brick (difficult will differ with deep and shallow)*

Shallow Guard you must be able to complete the following:

- o Swim 50 meters*
- o Swim a distance of 10 ft underwater and retrieve a 10lb brick*

Deep Guard you must be able to complete the following:

- o Swim 200 meters*
- o Retrieve a 10lb diving brick from the bottom of the pool (feet first)*
- o Tread water for 2 min without using your arms*

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Arrival Instructions:

We recommend that you fly into William P. Hobby International Airport (HOU) as this is the closest to Galveston, Texas. You can also fly into George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH). Both are located in Houston. Once you arrive, you are responsible for your own transportation to Galveston Island. You can utilize Uber, Lyft, a taxi, or the Galveston Express. It will cost between \$50-\$100 depending on the method of transportation. Depending on traffic, and which airport you are leaving from, the trip can take between 30-90 minutes.

When you arrive in Galveston, you can proceed directly to The Inn at the Waterpark, where you will be staying. You will be able to check in at any time. The address is 2525 Jones Dr. Galveston, Texas 77554.

If you arrive during our Human Resource business hours (typically 9am-5pm), you will want to check in at Human Resources which is located at 2318 83rd Street, Galveston, Texas 77554. If you arrive outside of those hours, please come the next day. Human Resources is open 7 days a week.

Human Resources is within walking distance from The Inn at the Waterpark.

TRAINING AND ONBOARDING

Participants must log-in to their associate life portal and complete their housing application, read and sign the housing contract, and pay the housing deposit before arriving to their assigned housing in Texas.
