Job Description:

Line cooking duties include working the pantry station (building salads, sandwich, and other appetizers). Other stations would be building pizzas and cooking pizzas in a gas oven, working the fryer station and grill. These can be burgers, chicken burgers, philly cheese steaks, salmon.

Typically it would be 4-5 days a week, 8-10hr days. These can be any days of the week based on schedule. business hours are 11am-9pm. Opening shifts begin 8am and closing shifts end around 10pm.

All staff receive a shift meal at the end of a shift (min shift 5hrs), staff receive 35% of clothing/merchandise sold at the brewery and 20% food when dining outside of work.

The shuttle runs Mon-Friday departs SEA each weekday by 11:45 am to catch the 2:40 ferry to Friday Harbor for \$75.
