Job Description:

Daily cleaning of cottages and common areas. Common areas include the recreation hall, kitchen, event barn, pool bar, pool restrooms, recreation hall restrooms. Cottages are fully equipped (like a home) which need to be cleaned including kitchen, bedrooms, living rooms, floors, bathroom. Blankets / Linens / Towels are to be replaced and laundered. We also offer daily towel exchanges on request. Recreation restrooms need to be cleaned and serviced twice a day. Pool towels need to be collected, laundered and replaced. Event hosting is needed on holidays and weekends for campground guests. Food and beverage service at the pool and event barn, in which tips are available. Resort staff members will also be asked to host and administer events, such as but not limited to event staff, smores socials, kids painting

sessions, kids basketball socials. Instructions and products needed to host are provided.

Typical Schedule:

Hours are 5 or 6 hours a day, 5 or 6 days a week. Some days may have divided hours such as 8a-12p and 4p-6p on one day. Days and hours can be traded with other student July through September.

Option 2) Fly into Boston Logan International Airport (BOS) and then a bus to Portland, ME and then will be driven to 4 hours to Eastport. The Concord Coach Bus is a fantastic option directly from the airport to get to Portland, ME.

If a late arrival, an overnight home is available to stay in the Portland rather than immediately driving.
